The Toastmasters Youth Leadership Program is designed to develop the speaking and leadership skills of young people through practical experience. Students learn how to prepare and present a speech, conduct meetings, listen effectively, and share evaluations. By the end of the program, students will have developed self-confidence and interpersonal communication skills to use for the rest of their lives.

Members will learn about this exciting program, ways to become involved, and how the Toastmasters Youth Leadership Program can be an effective public relations tool for your club and community!

BIO: In 2018, after 20 years in the fields of administration, human resources, project management, and proposal development, Linda Clark joined Toastmasters to “stand around and tell stories.” She enjoys sharing her life experiences, creativity, and wisdom and was District 5’s 2021 Humorous Speech Contest Winner.
