Bio: Charley Patton, DTM PRA, joined Toastmasters in December 2006 a few months after his home club chartered. Shortly after joining his home club, Charley became the Club President ('07), then an Area Governor ('07-'08), Lt Governor Education and Training ('08-'09), District Governor ('09-'10), and finished out the latter half of the Lt Governor Marketing term (Jan-Jun '11). During his District Governor year, District 5 achieved Distinguished status for the fifth year in a row, for which he happily received the Excellence in Leadership award on behalf of the members. In'17-18, Charley was privileged to be appointed Region 2 Advisor. Charley has since stayed active at the region level providing training, speeches, and mentoring around Southern California. He has earned the DTM award three times under the legacy education program, and is working on completing his fourth via Pathways.


